Results of Good Manufacturing Practices cGMPs

- Prior to 1978, the violation rate for sulfa drug residues were 13% in pork.
- □ Between 1980 to 1987, the violation rate dropped to 5%.
- □ Recently, the violation rate was less than 1%.
